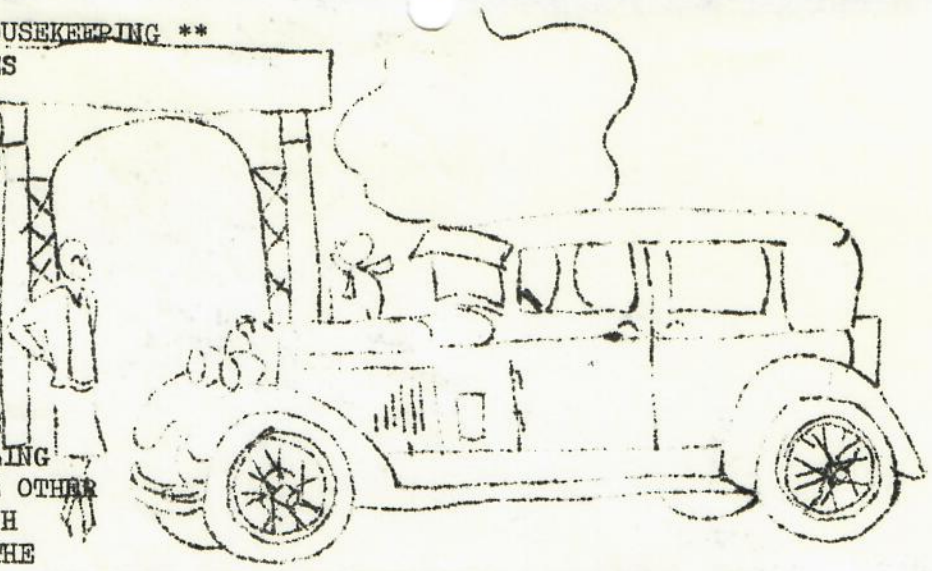
OCT. 24th AT KNOTTS BERRY FARM
