Technically Speaking

Taken from Ford service bulletins:

Sometimes owners experience difficulty in releasing the emergency brake lever after the emergency brake has been tightly applied. This is caused by failure to first pull the lever back slightly before pressing down on the release button.

The speed of the vacuum type windshield wiper blade can be regulated by means of the operating switch rod. For example, pushing the switch rod all the way in gives the maximum wiping speed to the wiper blade. Tushing the rod only part way in cuts down the speed of the blade so that it gives a slower wiping action.

The size of the crankshaft rear bearing cap oil pipe has been changed from 5/16"to 3/8". Increasing the size of the oil pipe allows the oil to drain more quickly from the main bearing into the oil pan tray especially in cold. weather.
