



CARBURETORS High Speed Troubles

Assuming the engine idle is good but has no speed or power, don't disturb the adjusting screws...

Turn the choke rod knob open to increase gas flow to the cap jet. If performance improves, the main jet may be clogged or gas flow may be to little for higher engine speeds...


