Tech Tip for the month:
Have you ever wondered if your
Generator was overcharging on a
long trip? When should you turn
your lights on to reduce the
overcharge condition if your
charging rate is too high? I
have found from experience that

by just touching the ampmeter you can tell when it starts to get really warm. When you feel it getting hot turn on your lights and save burning up that generator. Sounds like a strange way to protect a system but it works, just feel the gauge every twenty minutes or so on a long trip and it'll tell you when it's overloaded.






## BOWLING
