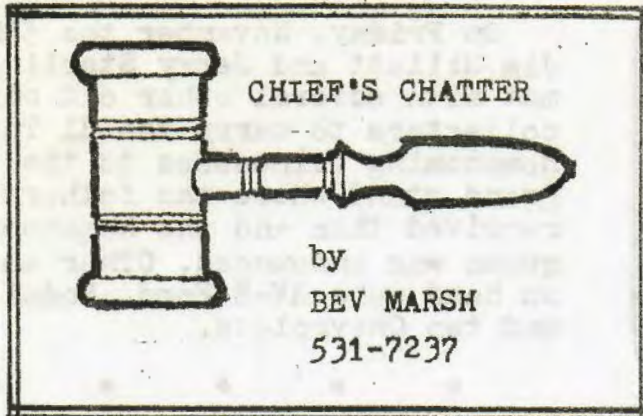

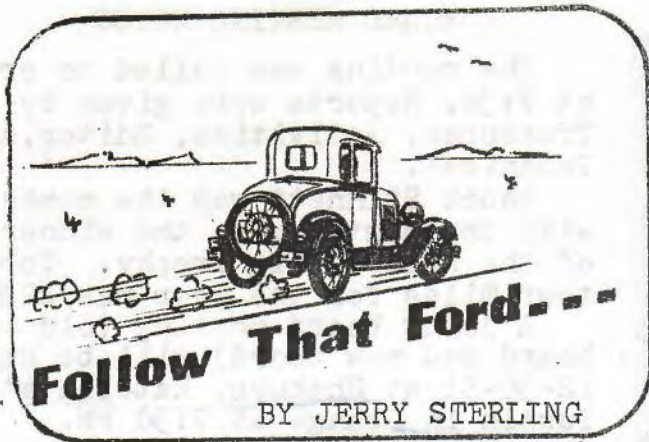

1 pkg. yellow cake mix  
1 pkg.. 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. instant chocolate pudding.  
1 cup oil  
4 eggs  
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup Vodka  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  cup coffee liquor  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  cup water

FROSTING

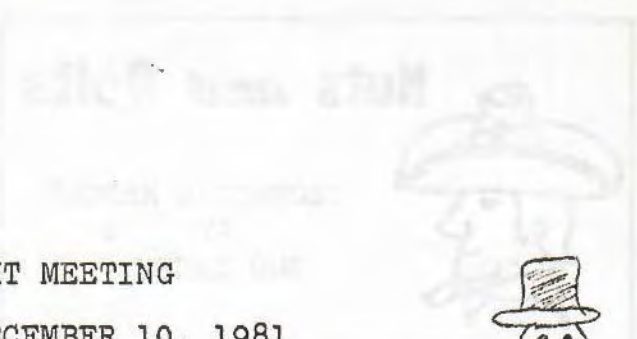
