

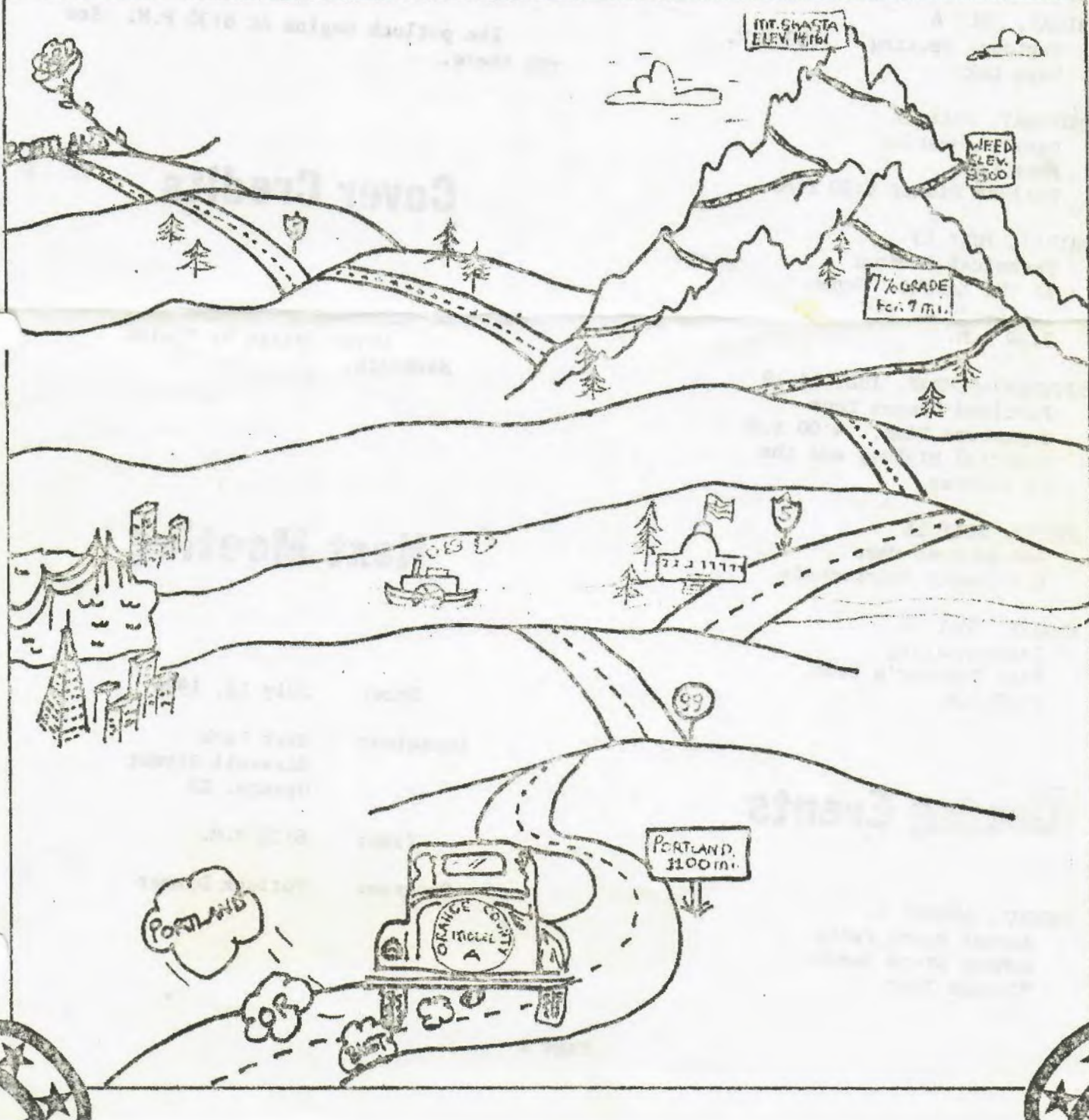

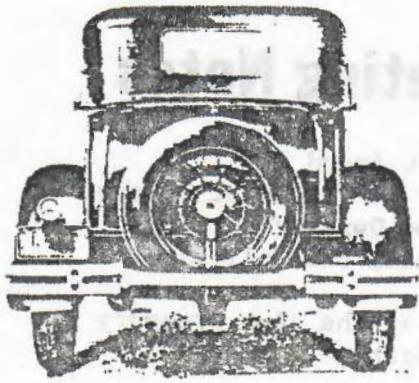

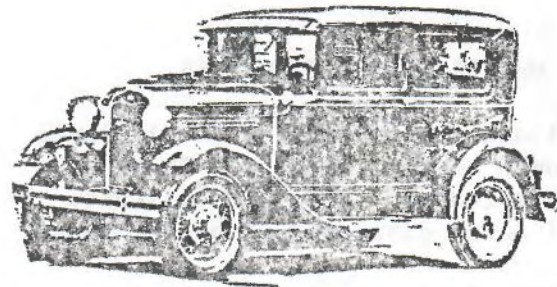
## UPCOMING EVENTS

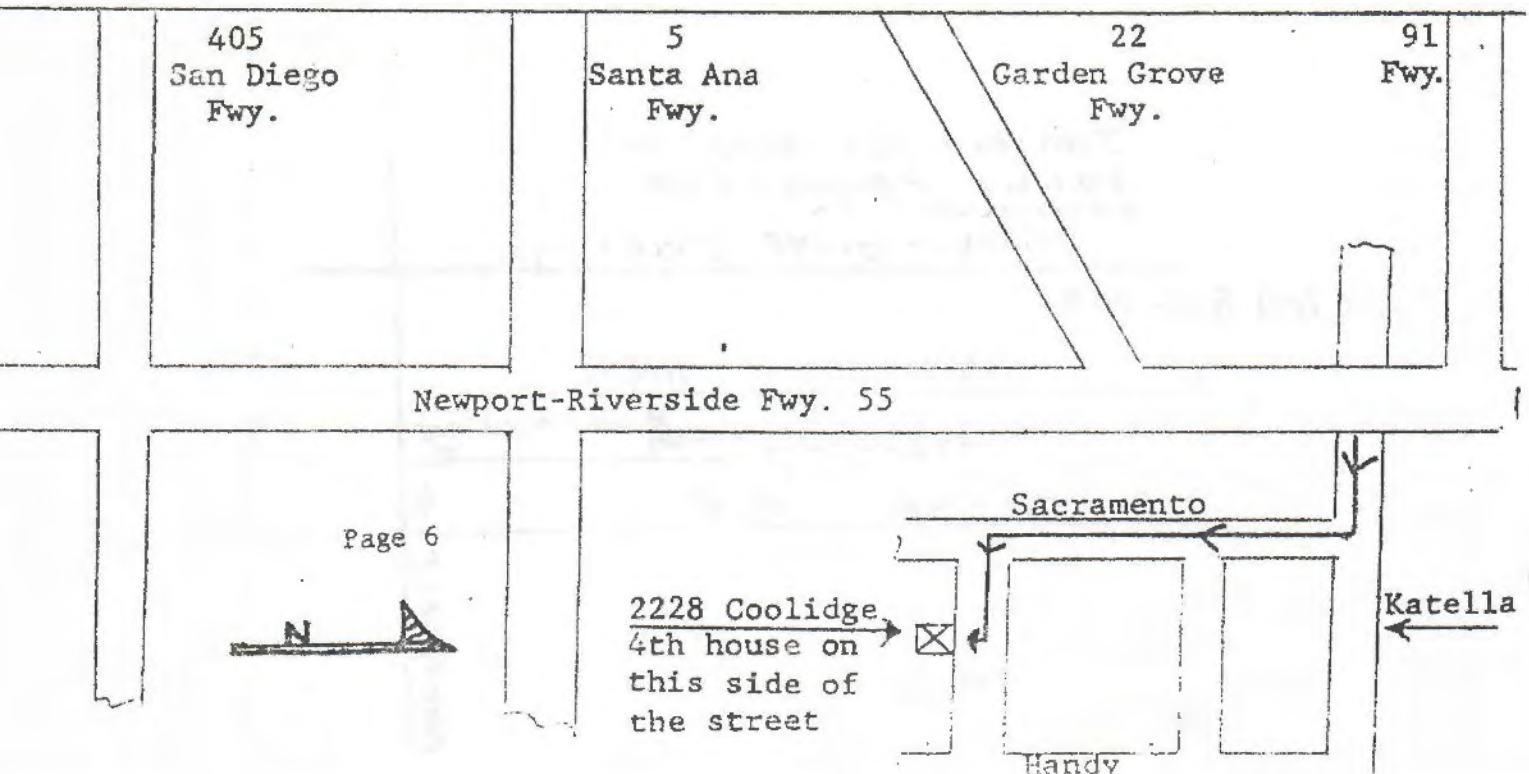

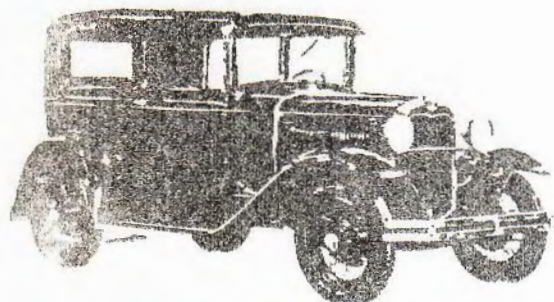
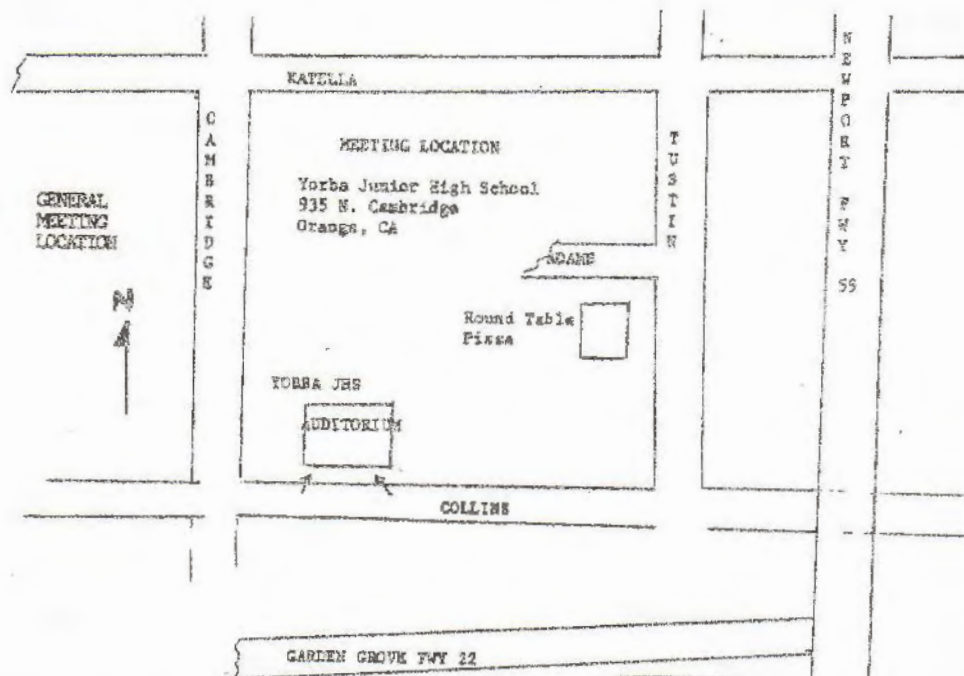
