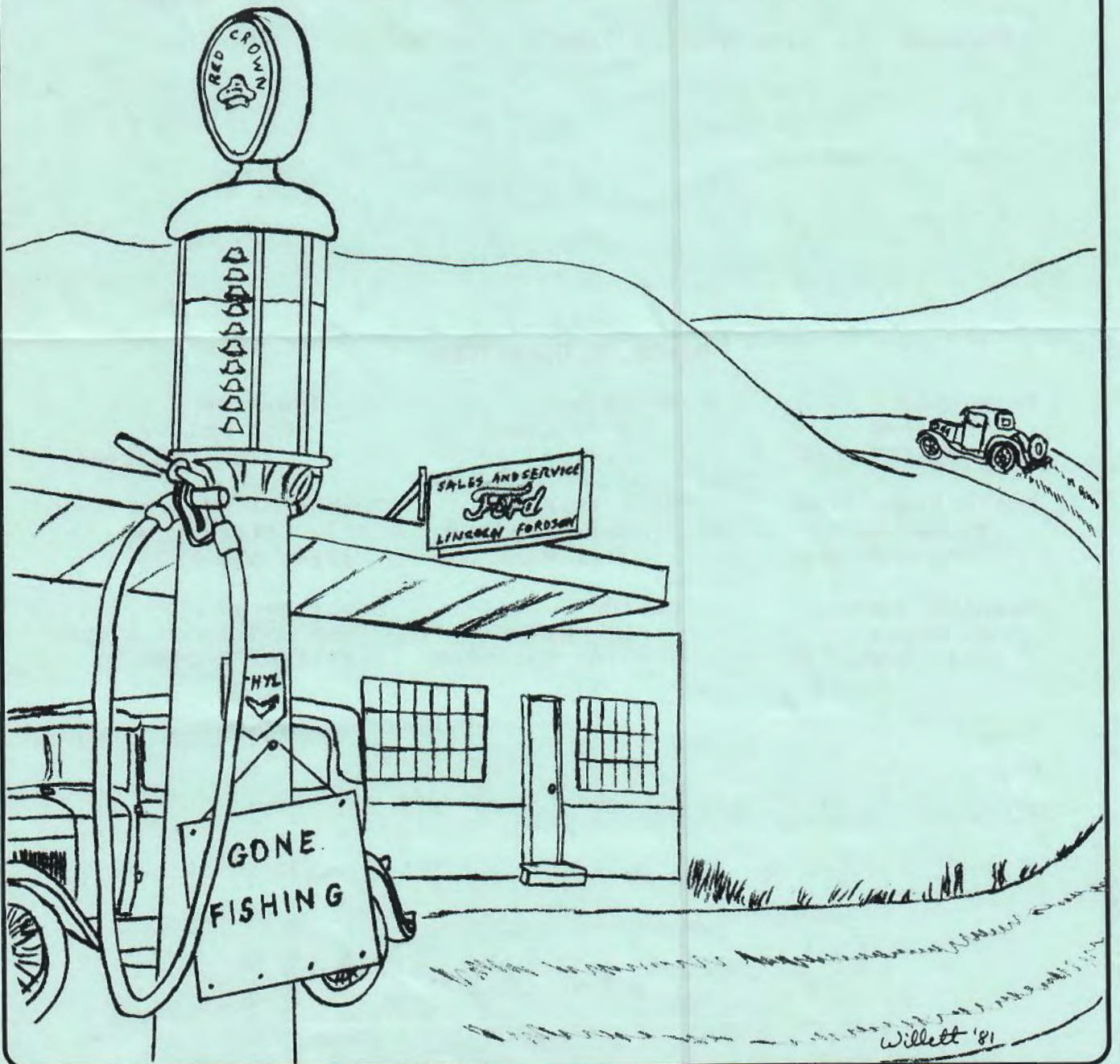

Up-coming Tours

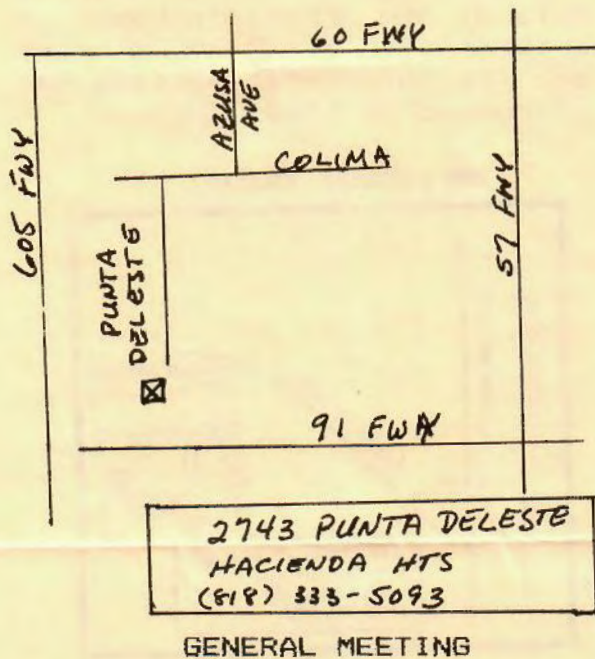

We have not selected a permanent place for our general meetings, but we have several of options. We are in the process of checking them out.

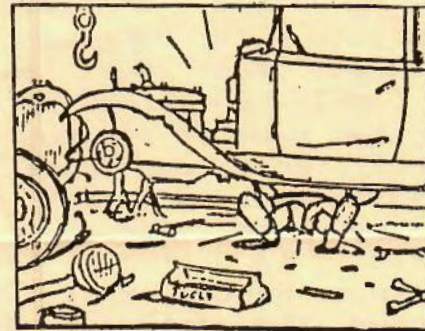
