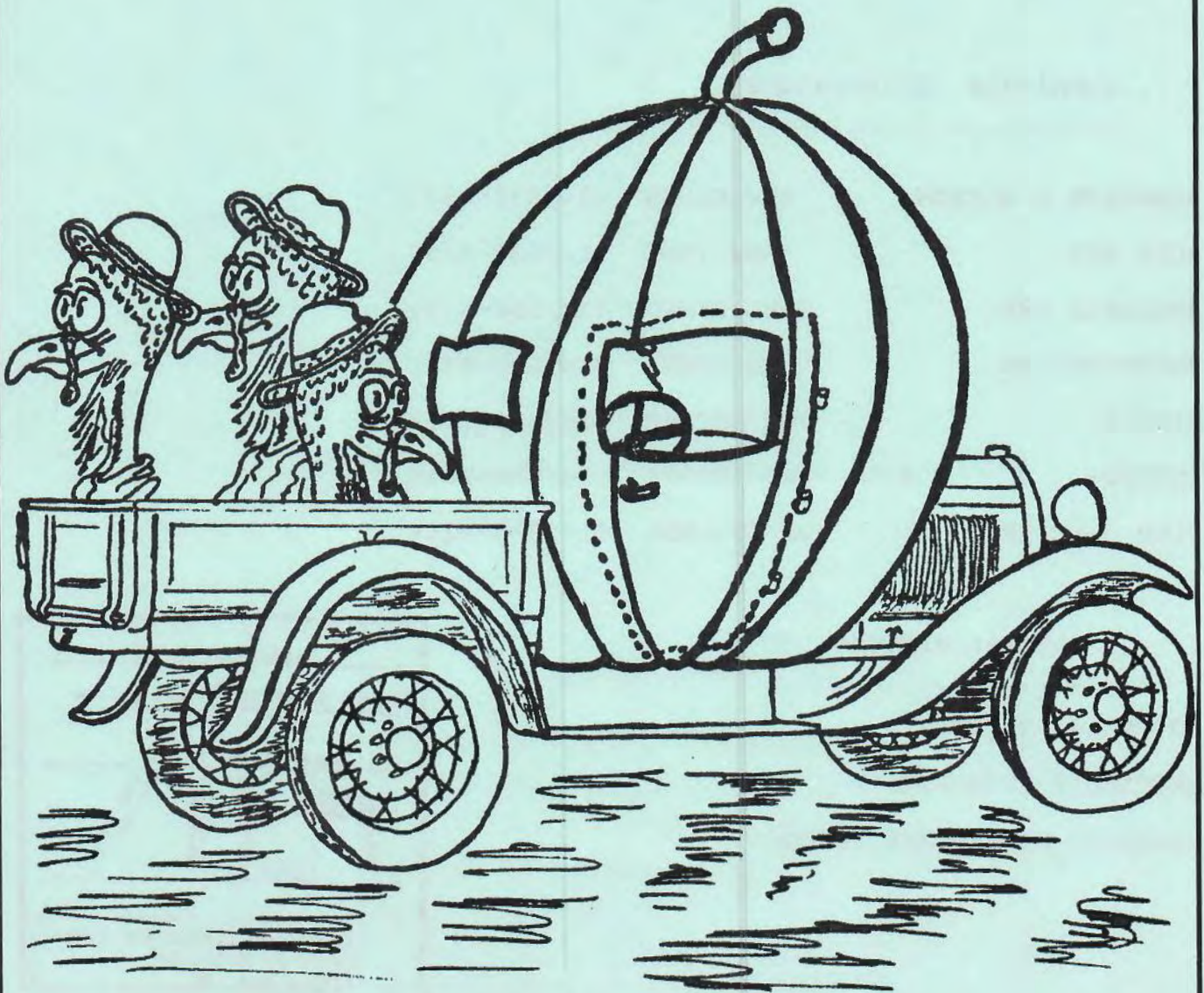

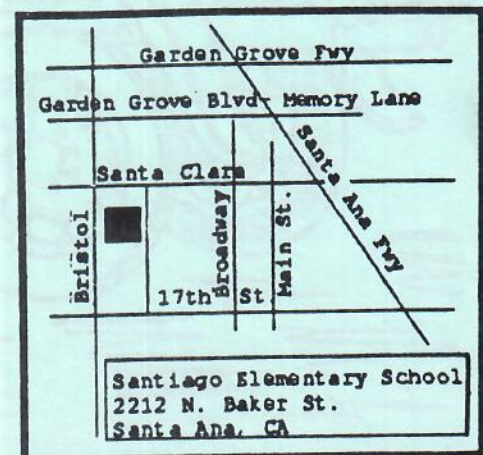

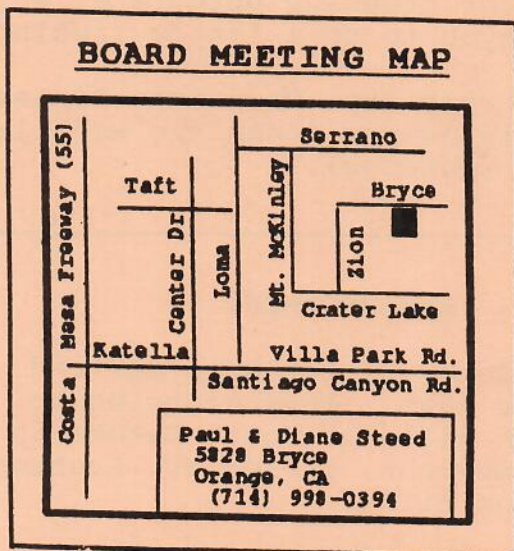

The board approved chicken and ribs as the menu for the Christmas party and set the price at \$40 per couple. Please pay Les by November 20th.

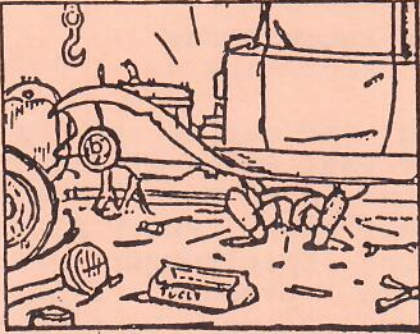
Les will take orders for enamel Model A pins from New Zealand at the next meeting.
