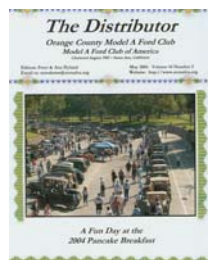

OCMAFC SCHOLARSHIP

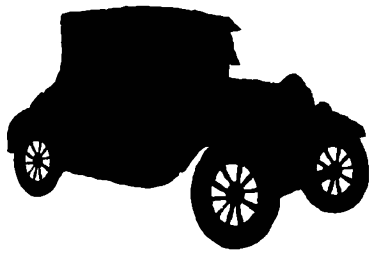

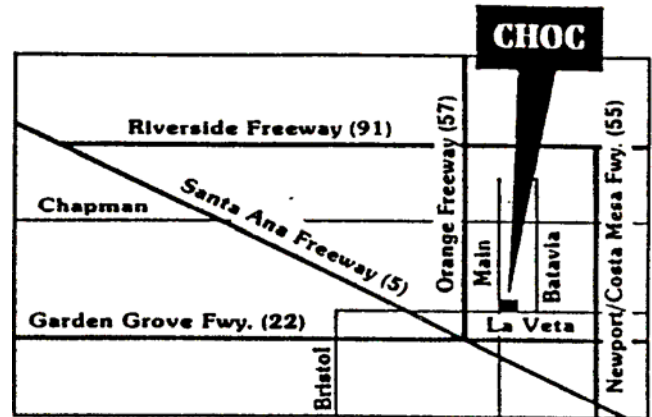
