Technical 2005

April Seminar:

The April seminar will be held at Bill Shaner's house on Saturday, April 23, beginning at 8:30 a.m. The subject will be body to frame alignment. We will be doing the alignment on one of Bill's Model A's. The address is 306 W. South St. Anaheim. 714-758-8129. Glenn Johnson will be conducting the seminar. Those who have experience in this area are welcome and encouraged to assist.

March Seminar:

The March seminar concluded the part two session on distributor rebuilding and finished up some loose ends on Chris Foster's 1931 coupe. Among numerous other things, the car now has a rebuilt ahooguh horn, a rebuilt distributor, and a new set of 3X spark plugs. Quite a few distributors were completely rebuilt and as far as I was able to observe none sustained a cracked housing.

Water Inlet pipe:

At the March general meeting I announced that I had purchased 10 of the part number A-8291-B stainless steel water inlet pipes being newly marketed by the Aries muffler people. These pipes were made available to the membership at the discounted price of \$12. including tax and shipping. The regular price is \$16.00 plus tax and shipping. All 10 pipes were immediately sold out at the meeting. I have since ordered an additional 10 pipes and they will be offered at the April meeting for the same price of \$12. If anyone wants to be certain to buy a pipe at the April meeting, please call me (714-897-5861) and I will reserve a pipe for you. These pipes are made to the original Ford drawing (dated May, 1928) and look exactly like the original without the flat area, as do current reproduction pipes on the market. They are made of stainless steel, so they will not rust out. The pipes are unpainted and can either be painted black to look stock or polished out to provide addition dazzle to a hot looking engine.

Aries Muffler Purchaser:

The Aries muffler people have offered to sell us their mufflers at a quantity discount price. We would need quantities of either 4 or 10 to qualify for the discount. The regular price for a standard muffler is \$189. plus tax and shipping. The regular price for a stainless steel muffler is \$275. plus tax and shipping. For a quantity of 4 the price for the standard would be \$160. and for the stainless steel the price is \$220. Shipping cost is \$22. for a box of two, or \$11. for each. California tax would be added. For a quantity of 10 the price would be \$150. for the standard and \$220. for the stainless steel. We are allowed to "mix and match", which means as long as we have the quantities, they can be a mix of either standard or stainless steel. Shipping and tax would be the same. If there is enough club interest to put together a quantity purchase please let me know at the general meeting or give me a call. Once we have a commitment for a quantity purchase I will go ahead and make the purchase.

Safety First:

When replacing the muffler, make certain that you have the car properly sitting on jack stands and that it is safe to work underneath the car. ☺






