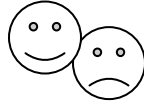

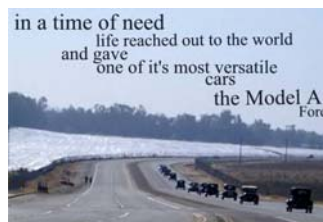

TECHNICAL 2007

At the September General Meeting there will be a sign-up sheet for the Meguiar tour. You'll need to provide the names in your group, telephone/cell number(s), type of vehicle (i.e. coupe/roadster/modern). If you are planning on going but unable to attend the September General Meeting, please contact me so you will be accounted for; but no later than September 17th. I need an accurate count to tell the Meguiar Management prior to the event. If you do not own a Model A or have one under construction, please contact a fellow member and secure a ride. Meguiar is looking forward to seeing a lot of Model A's. If you do not own or working on a Model A please don't be discouraged come and join the fun. I need to know who is attending. My phone number is (562) 869 0870 if I am not at home leave a message on the answering machine.

Discussion:

I attend many swap meets through out the year and come across many fellow club members who have questions about various items they see and or want to purchase but are uncertain as to the item being correct for their project. I am far from being an expert, but I do know a few things. 1) Research the application of the product(s) you're looking for. Many are interchangeable from year to year. Some are very specific to a model and year. 2) Consult with someone you have confidence with. 3) Utilize published text. 4) Just don't buy to be buying. You may end up with a lot of stuff to sell later.

During the last swap meet a new Model A'er and new member approached me and asked a question. "How can I tell from the fuel tank itself what year it will fit?" I told him I would be just guessing and referred him to someone who might just know. Later that week I thought about what he was after and begin to look deeper into his concern. I hope my findings will help those who need to know.

Four different gas tanks were made: 1) 1928/1929 had a screw-on gas cap. The front sheet metal on the front of the tank is also the top half of the firewall. 2) 1930/1931 has a twist-lock gas cap; 10 holes around the front to screw the front of the tank to the firewall. 3) A few interim tanks were made in early 1930 that are the same as 2, but had a screw-on gas cap (no firewall as part of the tank) 4) late 1931 was made the same as 2 except there was no gas shut-off valve on the bottom of the tank. The fuel outlet is a tube that comes straight out the front right side. It was used on the late 1931 "indented firewall" and the gas shut-off valve was moved to the side of the carburetor.

Keep the rubber on the road and have fun.

Huntington Beach



The photo above is of Huntington Beach High School shortly after its construction on Main Street in 1926. The construction was funded by the city of Huntington Beach during the peak of the oil boom. The architectural design is described as an excellent example of Lombard Romanesque Revival. The building on the extreme right with the bell tower is the auditorium.
