

54 members in attendance

The meeting was called to order and the flag salute led by Mark Schwing, President.

<u>Visitors</u> - Richard Parrish brought two guests Richard Morse and Aaron McIntyre [from New Zealand and Australia]. Members Don and Pam Chiapparine and Terry and Peg Carey have returned after a long absence.

<u>Minutes</u> - Corrections – Pam Heiland was the proud receiver of the Hard Luck Trophy for September, 2010. Mel and Terry Collings generously donated the food for the August monthly breakfast. With those corrections, the minutes of the September General Meeting were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - Joe Goff presented the Treasurer's report.

<u>Distributor's Report</u> - Mark Schwing reminded everyone that Pete Hyland is going on vacation and will need all input for the Distributor ASAP.

<u>Technical director's report</u> – Tom Endy will conduct an electrical seminar on Saturday at CHOC. Bob Jeffries and Jim Bush visited the Bannister's home to look at their amazing 1928 Pierce Arrow.

Activities – Bev Marsh reminded everyone of the upcoming Palm Springs Follies tour. The Installation Banquet will be held on 12/5/10 at the Black Gold Golf Club. There were no nominations from the floor. A motion was duly made by Drain Marshall, seconded by Mark Schwing and unanimously approved by the membership to accept this slate of officers. Additionally, Don Ratzlaff was elected by the Board for a term of 1-year as VP/Activities Director. Kathie McCall also asked the membership to think about who they would like to see as a Member of the Year.

<u>50th Anniversary</u> – Mark Schwing will investigate the cost of medallions for radiators in celebration of the club anniversary for every family who renews their membership.

Borg Warner overdrive for sale

This is a very well constructed modification for a Model A Ford. I completely disassembled it and thoroughly cleaned and inspected everything. The front and rear overdrive bearings were replaced with sealed bearings. The front and rear seals, along with the solenoid seal and the shift lever seal were replaced. The operating controls come with it and a 6 or 12 volt solenoid is included. The front and rear housing tubes were bead blaster and repainted. The unit has been bench checked under power and it works perfectly and can be demonstrated.



I can also build up a rear end with all new bearings and seals, and with the choice of a good serviceable 378 or 411 ring & pinion and with serviceable axles, and attach the overdrive to it. The proper pre-loads and the backlash will also be set. Or I can rebuild your rear end in the same manner and attach the overdrive.

The price of the overdrive by itself is \$900. With it attached to either rear end option above, the total price is \$1600. The price does not include installation in a car.

Like everything else I rebuild and offer for sale it comes with a money back guarantee.


