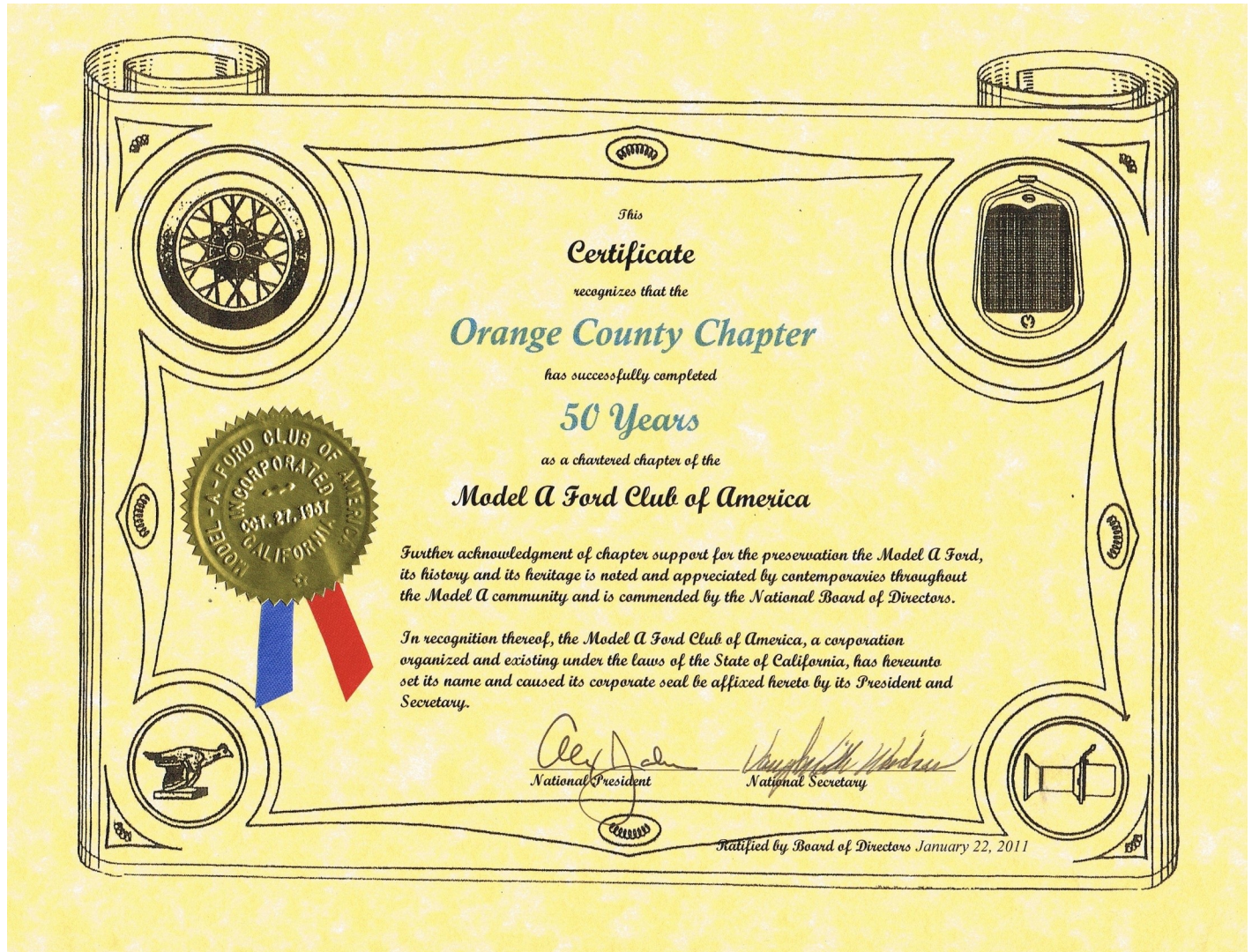

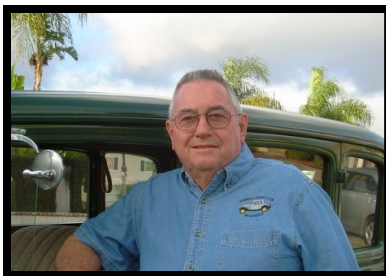

Don Ratzlaff had a good turnout to the Dana Point shopping center opening and I understand they had a good Mexican dinner in the deal.

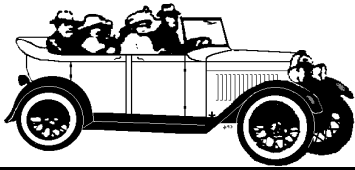

HISTORIANS CORNER

Dick Smith, Club Historian 7/2011

When refurbishing our cars it might be helpful at swap meets to know what other years, models of parts will fit your project, i.e. doors, fenders etc.

So this month, the "Historians Corner" will look at some interchangeable body parts.

Doors

- 1926-1927 Model "T" Tudor and Coupe doors will interchange with 1928-1929-early 1930 Closed Cab Pickup.
- 1928-1929 Tudor and Coupe doors will interchange with each other.
- 1930-1931 Pickup and Tudor doors interchange with each other.
- Roadster, Roadster Pickup, and Phaeton front doors are all interchangeable within the same year.
- Victoria and A-400 doors are the same.
- Murray Body Sedan doors will NOT interchange with Briggs Sedan doors. (see exception below)
1931 Slant Window, all Murray, Briggs, Ford bodied Sedan doors are interchangeable.

Fenders

- Roadsters, Coups, Cabriolets and Pickups of the same year are interchangeable.
- Sedans, Phaetons, Woody Wagons and Victoria's of the same year are interchangeable.
- Rear fenders on the late 1931 Pickup with the "wide bed" are NOT interchangeable with anything else. The same is true of the Tudor Deluxe Phaeton rear fenders.

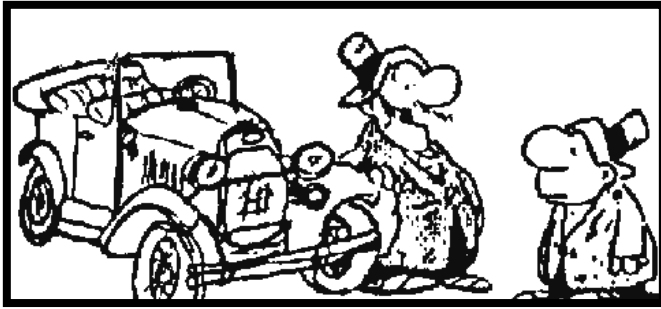

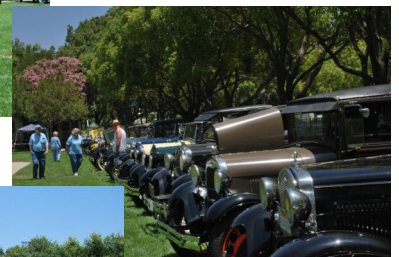
More on the Henry Ford Picnic

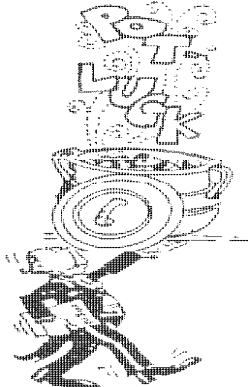

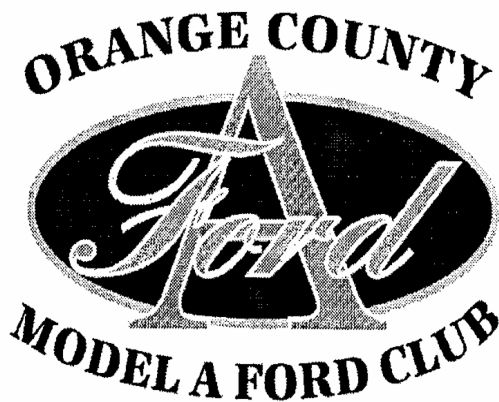
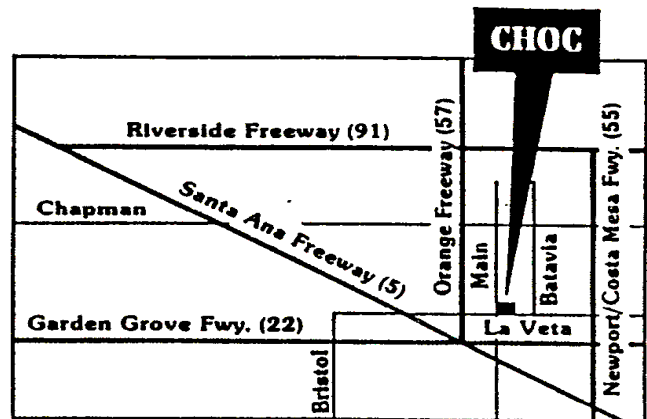
